

It was **RESOLVED** that any amenity under the control of Leisure East Devon should remain under their management, provided LED remained in being after any changes in Local Government.

It was RESOLVED that no transfer should be accepted without income to cover the expenditure.

It was **RESOLVED** that

(1) East Devon District Council be thanked for supplying an idea of expenditure and income in respect of amenities in Sidmouth for possible transfer, but it was apparent that these were not a definitive costing and could only be used as a guideline.

(2) Assets identified were divided into Freehold Transfers and Other Transfers.

EDDC to be notified of the following seven freehold amenities which the Town Council wished to see protected for Sidmouth and possibly transferred to the Town Council - with appropriate revenue to cover expenditure:

- 1 Norman Lockyer Observatory
- 2 Radway Cinema
- 3 Golf Course & Clubhouse
- 4 Lifeboat Station
- 5 Manor Pavilion & Arts Centre
- 6 Sailing Club premises
- 7 Tennis Courts, Bowling Green & Putting Green
