11:04/T6.2 Stowford Community Centre CIC had requested the use of Manstone Recreation Ground on Saturday 4th June from 10.00am until 5.00pm for a Summer Fair. They confirmed that the Football Club had given the use of their buildings for the day.

11:04/T6.3 The Secretary of the Sidmouth Town Amateur Football Club had written to report that they intended to apply for planning permission for ground improvements to enable them to achieve higher league football. They were taking this step because of the delay with regard to the nursery move and wrote that any work relating to the covered accommodation would be reversible should the nursery's ambitions come to fruition. Copies of the plans were available at the meeting for Members consideration.

RESOLVED: That Sidmouth Town Council support this plan in principle but consider that the proposed grasscrete footway should either be removed or replaced by a coloured tarmac path. The Chairman and Vice Chairman to consult with the Football Club on this matter and a final decision delegated to the Chairman of the Council.
